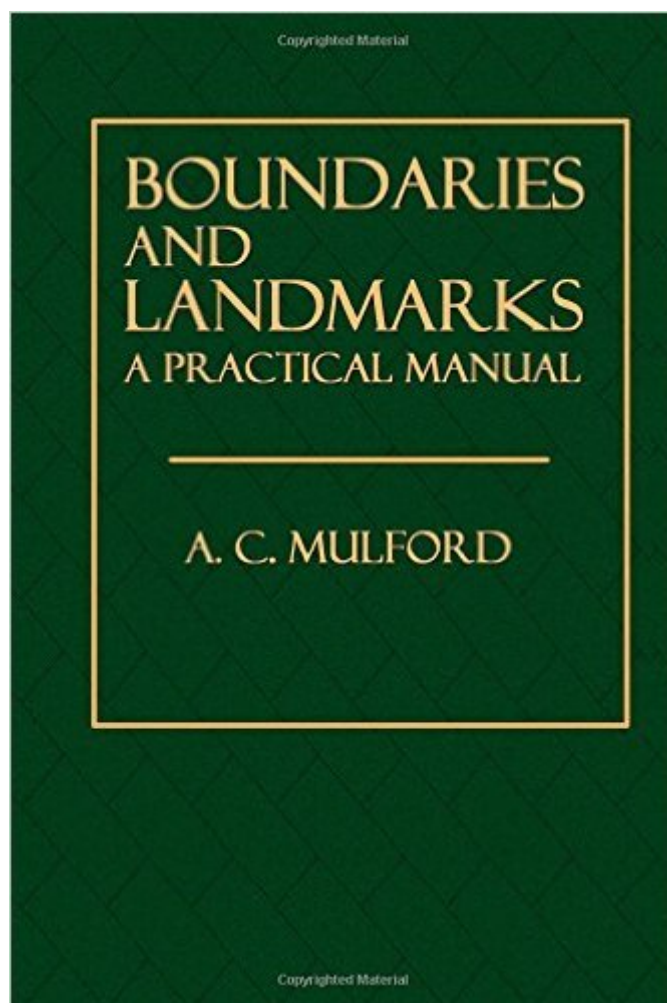

No attempt is made to describe how the lines should be measured; the intent is rather to furnish suggestions as to the method of locating the line to be measured â" in short, finding it. This little book covers the details of retracement of older surveys. Where does the line actually fall

relative to a split rail fence? At what point on the stone is the true corner? In addition to being enjoyable reading, the last chapter should serve as an inspiration to every professional surveyor. In fact, I think the last chapter should be mandatory reading for every applicant for licensure.
